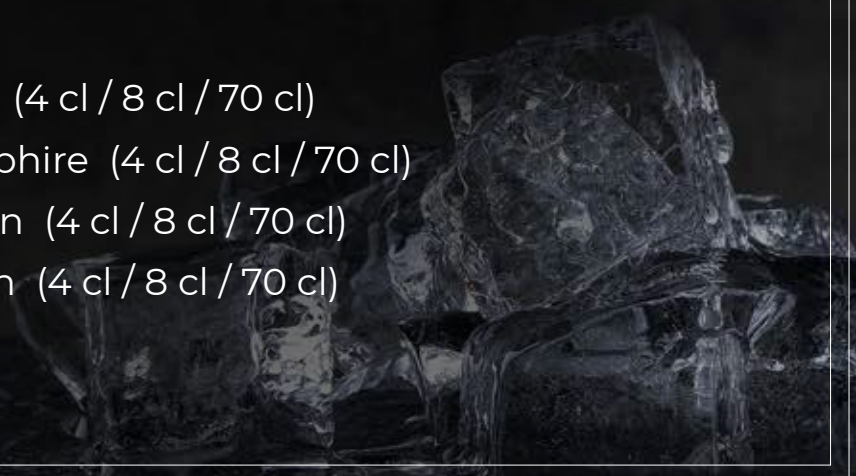

Mojito Drake

The discovery of Mojito Drake, which is accepted as the national drink of Cuba, dates back to 1500s. Said to be drunk by the English sailor, Francis Drake, in Cuba during his expeditions into the continent and accepted as the original form of Mojito Drake, the drink was known as "El Draque" early on.

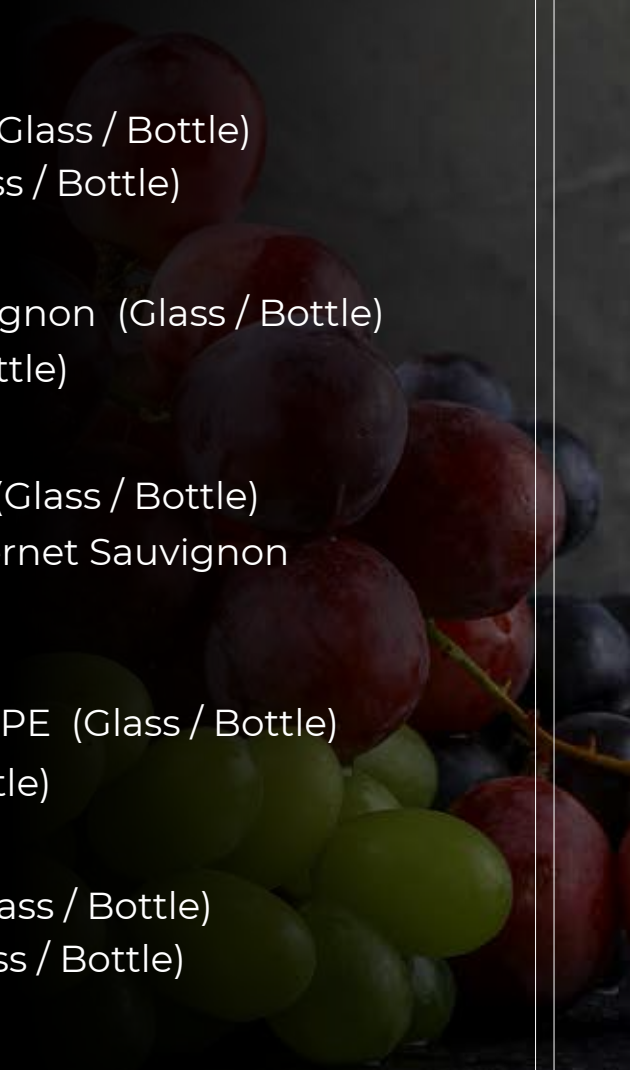
